Her practice includes disadvantaged/under and never-served forensic populations in Memphis, TN and nationally. She maintains an active faculty practice. Her research interest is in forensic nursing practice and interpersonal violence across the life span, its effects on individuals and populations, policy development, program evaluation and violence prevention initiatives.

Dr. Speck was a primary author of ANA's Forensic Nursing: Scope and Standards of Practice (2008). Her SANE Program Evaluation Questionnaire (SPEQ) has been adapted to support Department of Justice Technical Assistance to SARTs nationally through the International Association of Forensic Nurses (IAFN). Dr. Speck was IAFN President (2003-4).
